



RESOLUTION OF THE AUSTIN NEIGHBORHOODS COUNCIL EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE REGARDING THE CODENEXT CODE APPROACHES.

WHEREAS, the CodeNEXT Code Approach decision is one of the most important decisions that will be made on the CodeNEXT project; and

WHEREAS, the Code Approach decision will set the direction for the remaining three to four years that it will take to complete and fully implement the CodeNEXT project; and

WHEREAS, the Code Approach decision will establish the foundation for the new land development code; and

WHEREAS, the new 10-1 City Council will be responsible for implementing the new land development code based upon the Code Approach; and

WHEREAS, a decision on the Code Approach by the current City Council will bind the hands of the 10-1 Council and inhibit its ability to consider which Approach is best for citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Code Approaches presented by Opticos lack the clarity and detail necessary for the public and City Council to make an informed decision; and

WHEREAS, Code Approach #3 is too radical, expensive, time-consuming, and not recommended by most of the boards and commissions that reviewed it;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Austin Neighborhoods Council (ANC) Executive Committee strongly urges the Austin City Council to postpone action on the Code Approach decision so that the new 10-1 Council can determine which Approach is best for Austin.
