



**RESOLUTION OF THE AUSTIN NEIGHBORHOODS COUNCIL EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE REGARDING TRAFFIC IMPACT ANALYSIS AND FUNDING FOR TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE**

**WHEREAS**, the Garza Ranch project highlighted the City's policies regarding approval of development projects in areas where the transportation infrastructure is failing to handle existing traffic or insufficient to handle the projected increase in traffic; and

**WHEREAS**, the Garza Ranch project also highlighted the chronic problem with insufficient funding for upgrades to and new transportation infrastructure for development; **NOW, THEREFORE,**

**BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Austin Neighborhoods Council (ANC) Executive Committee hereby petitions the City Council Committee on Mobility to review best practices, strategies, and policies at peer cities regarding:

Traffic impact analysis for development projects,

Funding for upgrades to and new transportation infrastructure for development and growth, and

*Evaluation* of applications for development projects in areas with insufficient or failing transportation infrastructure; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT** the City Council Committee on Mobility conduct a public hearing on the results of the review within 60 days of the date of the date of this resolution.
