



RESOLUTION OF THE AUSTIN NEIGHBORHOODS COUNCIL'S EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE REGARDING THE COUNCIL RESOLUTION TO ADD TWO ADDITIONAL MEMBERS TO THE CODE ADVISORY GROUP

WHEREAS, the Austin Neighborhoods Council (ANC) has consistently expressed concern that the **Code Advisory Group** (CAG) does not sufficiently represent the interests of stakeholders for neighborhoods and the environment; and

WHEREAS, the CAG has the responsibility to make decisions and recommendations regarding the CodeNEXT process and ultimately the land development code that will impact all neighborhoods, businesses, and citizens in the City; and

WHEREAS, the CAG also has the primary responsibility to facilitate public outreach throughout the CodeNEXT process; and

WHEREAS, the City has acknowledged the ANC as a key stakeholder in the CodeNEXT process; and

WHEREAS, the ANC represents neighborhoods throughout the City and is the largest member-representative (umbrella) neighborhood group within Austin and in the CodeNEXT process; and

WHEREAS, Mary Ingle, President of the ANC, has broad and deep knowledge of and experience working with neighborhoods across the City on neighborhood plans and land development code issues; and

WHEREAS, Bill Bunch, Executive Director of Save Our Springs, is among the most knowledgeable and experienced citizens on the impact of growth and development on the environment and water in the City and surrounding Hill Country; and

WHEREAS, appointing Mary Ingle and Bill Bunch to the CAG will significantly enhance and facilitate public outreach to stakeholders for neighborhoods and the environment; and

WHEREAS, members of the City Council have sponsored a Council resolution to add two additional members to the CAG; and

WHEREAS, the Council resolution will be reviewed by the Council Committee on Planning and Neighborhoods;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the ANC Executive Committee hereby petitions the City Council Committee on Planning and Neighborhoods to:

1. Recommend that Mary Ingle be appointed to the CAG,
2. Recommend that Bill Bunch be appointed to the CAG, and
3. Direct the City Manager to prohibit the CAG from voting or making recommendations on any matters until the two new members are seated on the CAG.
